## Pair saddle up for bike ride to Paris

**THREE** avid bike riders from Wyifa and Trawsfynydd site are planning an epic journey from Parys to Paris.

Stephen Fell and Warren McDonough from Wyifa and Robin Phillips from Trawsfynydd will be riding a huge 450 miles route to raise money for Cancer Research UK and the Alaw ward at Ysbyty Gwynedd.

The journey will start on May 16 at Anglesey's Parys Mountain, along a 310 miles route to Portsmouth and then a further 140 miles from Le Havre to the Arc de Triomphe in Paris, France.

They will be assisted by a

support vehicle carrying clothes, spare tyres and other equipment.

Warren, whose bicycle was built by Tony Oliver, a former engineer at Wyifa, said: "We thought about cycling from Land's End to John o'Groats, but then someone suggested Parys to Paris."

"It had a certain ring to it so we have planned a route and hope to complete the ride in a week."

Just three weeks before the ride, Stephen will be running in the Boston Marathon.
